Patient Management allows you to manage your facilities, patient profiles and drugs, import and add new patients. It provides you the flexibility to manage your drugs using Brand Swap and your patient's Virtual Pill Balance.

You will need to set-up a facility first to link your patients to the appropriate facility.

- 1. Select Facilities
- 2. Select New
- 3. Enter in facility *Code*
- 4. Enter in Dispense Code (Only applicable for Premium. This will link the facility in your dispense software)
- 5. Enter in *Name* and other applicable details.
- 6. Select *Blister Type* to be packed by this facility.
- 7. Select Facility Type
 - The following details will print on front of header card:
 - a. Community/self-care patient: Patient's name and address
 - b. Nursing Home/hostel patients cared for: Patient's name, facility and room number
- 8. Select Manifest for pick-up for delivery reporting purposes
- 9. Select Default Time-slots to adjust the name of each time-slot you wish to appear on the foil and blister.

- To search for patient, enter in either patient's First/Last name in the Name field.
- To display all patients within a specific facility, select *Facility* from the drop-down box.



- Import Photo/Erase Photo: Add or delete patient photos. Size Limit: 300KB
- *Import Document*: Documents in form of PDF, Word/Excel can be imported to save to patient's profile. Size limit: 50MB/file. Total limit for all files: 180MB.
- *Name, DOB, Facility, Gender, Ward* are auto populated when importing Patient's details from your dispense software. Alternatively, they can be added and edited manually.
- PAA DAA Funding: Select the options from the drop-down box in order to submit PPA claim.
- *Notes:* Add notes to display in the Notes column on the main Patient List page. It will also print on certain labels for blister packs.
- *Allergies:* Enter the drug or manual text that patient is allergic to. A warning will appear when any drug containing the same text is being added to patient's medication profile.
- Date Taken: Select date the photo was taken. This will appear under the patient's photo on certain reports and signing sheets.
- *Suspend Packing From:* Select date you wish to suspend packing from and to. Warning will appear when trying to print foil/labels with pack start date within this date range.



Virtual Pill Balance (VPB) is used to manage the balance of your patient's packed medications.

Initial Pill Balance Entry

Before you start using this function, you must enter the initial pill balance for all your patient's packed medications. Let's begin by printing a report to list all the medications that is required to be counted and recorded.

- 1. Select Virtual Pill Balance
- 2. Select Patient Balance tab
- 3. Select Facility
- 4. Select Search. This will display all patients with packed medications and their current VPB.
- 5. Select *Export Balance*. A confirmation message will indicate where the CSV file has been saved. You have the option to open the document by selecting *Yes* or navigate to the saved destination when you are ready.
- 6. Once you have counted the remaining balance of your patient's packed medications, enter the amount into the *Current Balance* column. Save and close your document.
- 7. Now you are ready to import the initial pill balance into myPak, select *Import from Excel*. Select the file that was saved in your designated location.
- 8. The remaining balance of your patient's medications will then be imported as the patient's initial pill balance.



Dispense Tracker

Dispense Tracker function is used to import the balance of the scripts dispensed from your Dispense Software to your patient's pill balance. You will need to ensure you have dispensed all the required prescriptions on your report or via QScript.

- 1. Select Virtual Pill Balance
- 2. Select Dispense Tracker tab
- 3. Select Active Packed tab to view scripts dispensed for active packed medications
- 4. Select Facility or All Facilities
- 5. Select the date range to load scripts dispensed within that period.
- 6. Select *Refresh from Dispensing* to load new, edited, or cancelled scripts that have yet to be imported into your patient's pill balance.
- 7. Select *Select all* tick box to select all scripts or alternatively manually select scripts you wish to import QTY to patient's pill balance.
- 8. Select Update Pill Balance to import selected script QTY to patient's pill balance.
- 9. Legend:
 - Green: New scripts yet to be imported
 - Yellow: Previously imported scripts with a change in QTY
 - Pink: Previously imported scripts that have been cancelled. Updating cancelled script will subtract the script QTY from the patient's pill balance.
 - Light Blue: Owing scripts yet to be imported
 - Bold Font: Indicates different brand dispensed from patient's profile





Unmapped Drugs

This tab allows you to map or link drugs from your Dispense Software to the existing drugs listed in myPak's drug database. Once the drug is mapped, it will now be displayed in your *Active packed* tab for ready for to be imported into your patient's pill balance.

It is highly recommended to check for any unmapped drugs once you have completed importing all the scripts from the *Active packed* tab. You can then map and import those drugs into your patient's pill balance.

Follow the following steps once you have loaded your scripts from your Dispense Software in *Dispense Tracker Active Packed* tab.

- 1. Select Unmapped tab
- 2. Select Facility
- 3. Select *Patient* to display a list of drugs dispensed within the select date range that requires to be mapped
- 4. Select the correct drug from the *Profile Drug* drop-down box for each drug in the list to be mapped (All drugs listed in the drop-down box are active drugs from patient's profile)
- 5. Enter Manually Add QTY if applicable for those drugs to be mapped
- 6. Select the *tick box* to map selected drugs
- 7. Select Import to update the select drugs into patient's pill balance
- 8. Alternatively, select Ignore Scripts for drugs that are no longer active in patient's profile.




This function has been designed to help you fill your blister accurately and efficiently by displaying a visual guide.

If you use Virtual Pill Balance, it is required to pack using this function to subtract the packed tablets from patient pill balance.

- 1. Select Packing & Checking
- 2. Select Packing tab
- 3. Scan the barcode located on the labels/foil in Scan Patient Barcode field
- 4. Select Facility
- 5. Select *Patient* to be packed
- 6. Select number of weeks to be packed (Tick Make Default to apply the setting to future patients)
- 7. Select the same Start Date that matches the label/foil to be packed
- 8. Scan the barcode of the first drug on the list OR manually select the drug and select confirm to start packing
- 9. Proceed to pack according to the visual guide (below is an example if 2 weeks to be packed)
- 10. Once you have completed packing, scan the drug once again to confirm it has been packed
- 11. Select *Record Packed* once all medications has been packed. This will subtract all *QTY Packed* from patient's pill balance.

Below highlight colours indicate the following status:

White Highlight	Indicates drug has NOT been scanned

Packing FAQ

• How do I revert the packed QTY back to not packed?

To reverse the packed balance from being subtracted, double click on the drug highlighted in **GREEN**. The drug will no longer be highlighted and the QTY Pack is now 0. This can only be done <u>before</u> **Record Packed** has been selected.

• I have selected number of pack weeks and start date but why do all the drugs appear GREEN?

Drugs highlighted GREEN indicates they've been packed. Check the start date selected matches the start date on your foil.

• I have scanned a drug and the following warning pops up "WARNING - Unable to find matched drug".

The drug scanned does <u>NOT</u> belong in the patient's profile. Select the correct medication and re-scan again. The barcode may incorrect. (See below how to manage barcodes)

• I am packing my own store brand drug; how do I add the barcode to the drug?

Follow the following steps to manage barcodes:

- 1. In Administration, select Drugs
- 2. Select Search

• Can I leave the packing screen to use another function within the software?

It is recommended to complete packing the blister before proceeding to the next task to minimize packing errors. A popup warning will appear warning you that there are outstanding drugs that have yet to be scanned and packed. Any drugs that have been confirmed must be reversed before exiting. You will need to re-scan those packed medications again. Alternatively, complete the pack.

Stock Forecast



 - Select *Search* to locate drugs either by scanning the barcode or entering in drug name. Double click on drug entry to view its details.


